Application Process

Q: What is the cost of the Application?

The SRCC GBO application process will only be completed once the application fee is paid. The fee payment is to be done online through credit card/debit card/ net banking.

Table below Shows the SRCC GBO application fee.

Q: What is the eligibility for applying to the Two Year Full-Time PGDM Programmes?

Candidates who have passed a bachelor's degree with a minimum 50% marks for the General Category and (45% marks for SC/ST) from any recognized University can apply for SRCC GBO exam.

Note: Candidates awaiting the final year result or pursuing final year are also eligible to apply for SRCC GBO entrance exam.

Q: Can students upload the Provisional certificate instead of the Graduation Certificate?

Yes, the students can upload the Provisional certificate instead of the Graduation Certificate.

Q: What is the procedure for submission of an online application?

- > Applications can be submitted only Online.
- ➤ Applications can be submitted through the Application Portal for which the candidate must have an internet connection with an online fee payment facility (Internet Banking / Debit Card / Credit Card)
- ➤ No manual/ paper application will be entertained.
- > Entries in registration and application form shall be filled only in English.
- ➤ Candidate to keep the required information handy with him/her before starting to fill up the online application form.

Selection Process

Q: How are the 'shortlisted' and 'selected' candidates informed?

Candidates will be able to check the scorecard online. A merit list will be released after the SRCC GBO exam which will contain the list of candidates who have cleared the exam, and they will have to appear for the GD-PI round for further selection procedure.

Q: When and where is the Selection Process conducted?

The SRCC GBO Entrance exam is conducted once a year in online mode.

The exam is conducted for **120 minutes** wherein candidates have to solve **160 MCQ-based** questions from 4 sections. The GBO entrance exam is level 1 screening and those candidates who clear the SRCC GBO cut-off are then further called for other rounds of selection which include: -

- 1. Group Discussion
- 2. Personal Interview

Below is the weightage being allotted to each round of selection. Candidates will be scored against their performance in each round before receiving the final call for selection: -

Q: What is the total intake of the PGDM GBO Programme?

The total number of seats available for admission is 90 including the reservation.

Q: What does the selection process comprise?

Selection Criteria for the course are based on an objective type of Online Test followed by Group Discussion and personal interview.

The online test shall comprise of the following components:

- (a) English Comprehension & Language Ability
- (b) Quantitative Ability
- (c) Logical Ability
- (d) Data Interpretation

The candidates must appear in the Online Test first. After the declaration of Online Test results, a limited number of candidates will be invited for the GDPI in order of merit under each category. Candidates with negative aggregate marks in the Online Test will not be eligible for the GDPI. Appearing in GDPI is a mandatory requirement for consideration of candidates in the Final merit list.

The final merit list will be drawn based on aggregate marks secured by the candidate in the online test and GDPI. The online test will have a 75% weightage and GDPI shall have a 25% weightage, of which GD shall have a weightage of 10% and PI shall have a weightage of 15%.

Q: Procedure for admissions under Foreign National Category

Candidates holding a valid Passport or Citizenship Card of any country, other than of India will be considered under the 'Foreign National Category. Candidates under the foreign Category are not required to appear for the Online test and GDPI.

Candidate in the final year of graduation should upload their previous year/semester mark sheets and must submit their qualifying degree and/or mark sheet after the declaration of final result of their qualifying examination.
